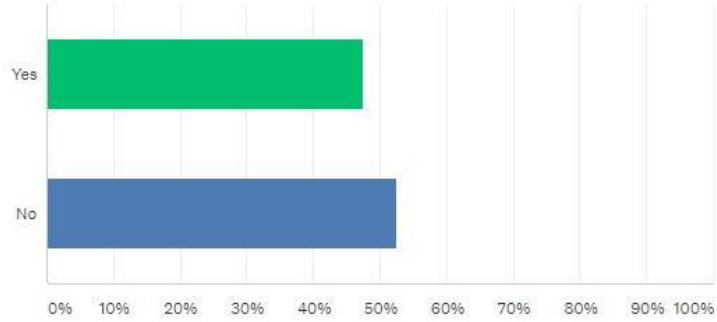

Answered: 82 Skipped: 0



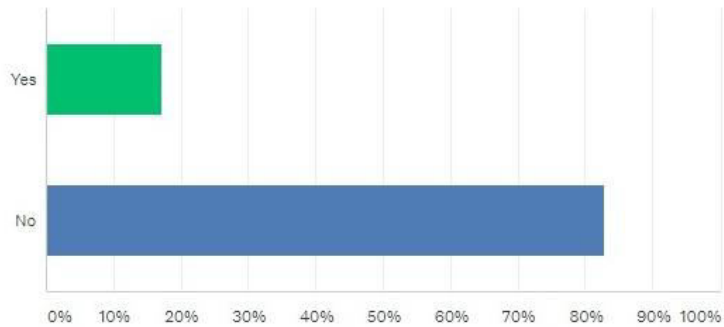

Answered: 82 Skipped: 0



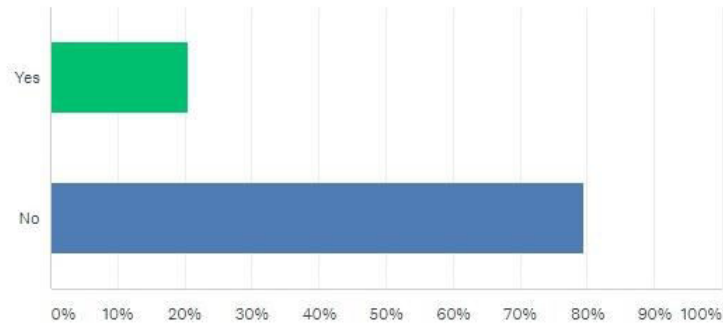

Answered: 83 Skipped: 0



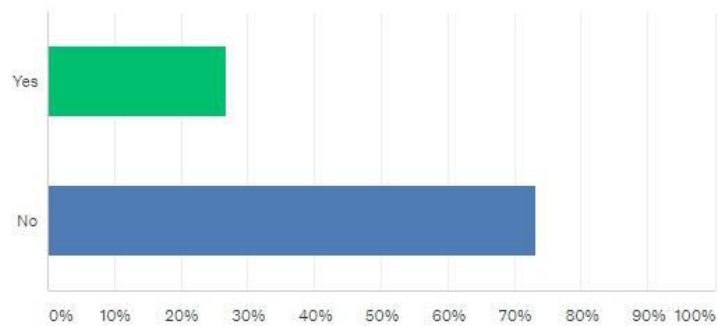

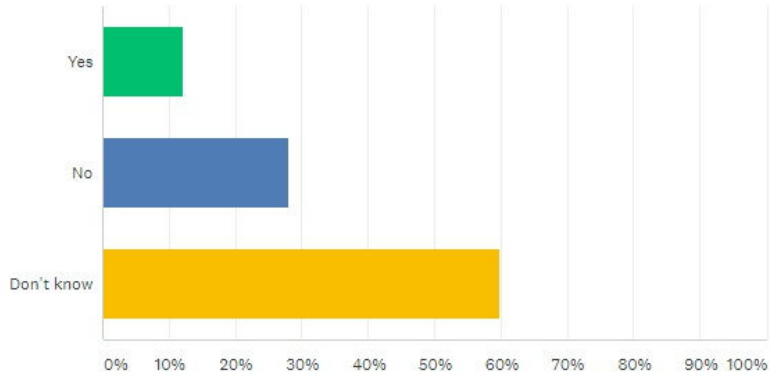

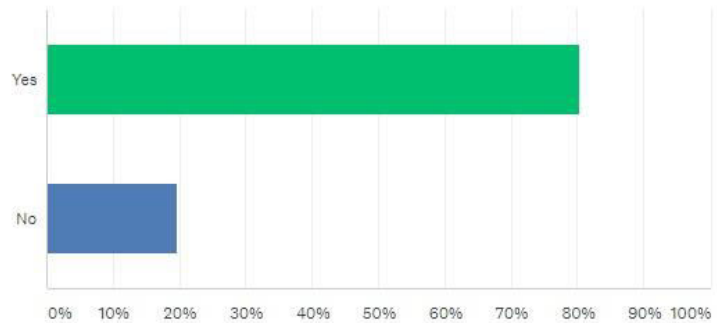

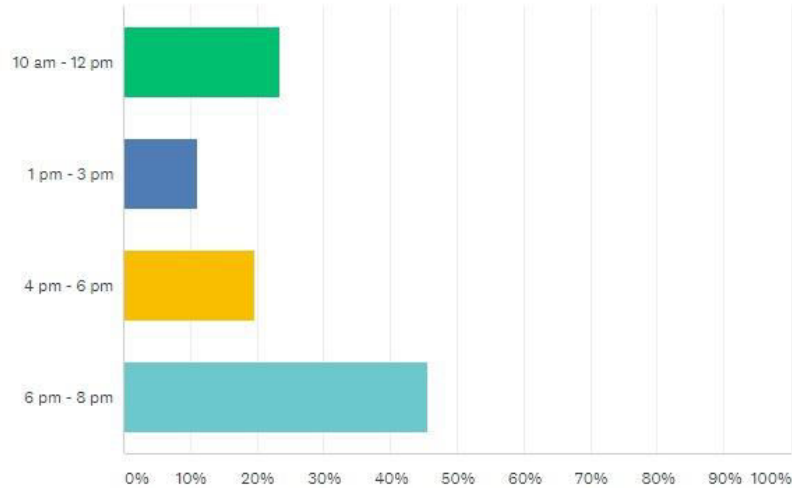

**Q8 Do you have any suggestions on how the computers could be used more?**

Answered – 66

Skipped – 17

- Advertise the computers locations and times to access them (posters, magnets, etc).
- Have elders and youth work together on the computers, both can share knowledge.
- Train community members to work with others on the computers.
- Have incentives or prizes for people who are learning the language through the program.
- Put computers in public spaces, NVIT, library, and schools were suggested.
- Place computers throughout the territory and at Nlaka’pamux Band offices.
- Create a weekly video lesson for a closed Facebook group.
- For those outside the territory, share information on how to connect with others who speak or want to learn the language.
- Create fun events for members to attend and try out the program.
- Go to all Nlaka’pamux Gatherings and promote live.
- Information session dinners.
- Create an app for the phone, it would be better used.

- Do not have a computer.
- Place computers in people's homes or rotate locations.
- More lessons in making sentences, pictures and spelling.

**On the Reserve**

- Nooaitch Youth Center. Somewhere open after work hours.
- One within each Band within the Nation.
- In selected homes on reserve or schools.
- Nlekepmx language nest!
- They'd get used more in our Band office rather than Hall, but we have no space.

**Off the Reserve**

- Off reserve access in the area our people are living.
- Nicola Tribal Association
- Members feel uncomfortable using the computers in the office.
- Advertise to people outside the Nation how to access and use the program.

**Public Space/After-hours access**

- Somewhere that has later hours than offices
- Library
- Put them where people gather like Shulus arena
- Friendship Centre
- Rotate between bands, or other learning spots
- Nicola Meadows needs newer computer systems
- Health center
- Local business's (It is our right – we should speak our language at stores, post offices, banks)
- Some cultural place, maybe the Elders Lodge with internet access covered for them.

**Other specific locations**

- In private homes
- Schools
- NVIT

**Other Ideas / Comments**

- Provide sticks with program access
- Advertise more
- If centrally located they're good where they are, just need more advertising that they're there.

- An app would get better use.
- It's difficult to reach communities that are slightly isolated or lack the technology.
- A laptop that people could sign out to use the program.
- Reward students who graduate high school or college with a language computer.
