The public comment period is now open for the Highland Valley Copper 2040 Project. The project is a proposed expansion of an existing copper molybdenum mine near Logan Lake.

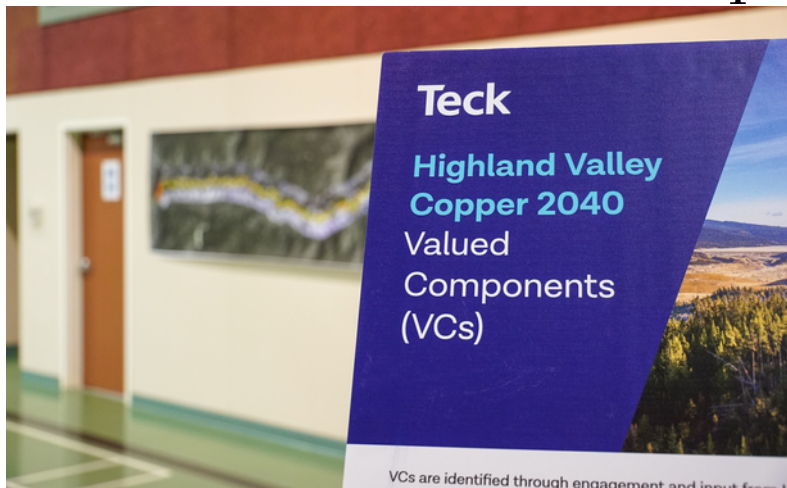
The comment period closes on November 14, 2022 at midnight.

The Environmental Assessment Office (EAO) is seeking public input on the draft process order, assessment plan and the regulatory coordination plan.

These documents set out how the EAO will conduct its environmental assessment of the project, what will be included in the assessment, the information that will be required, the methods to be used and the timelines.
